

Five New Members Join Epworth—

On Sunday, Dec. 17, the membership of Epworth grew by four professing members and one associate member. Each of the new members had years of affiliations with Epworth, but recently took classes to join. Our membership now stands at 393 professing members.

Joining as full professing members are Annette Nielson, Anne Osborne, and Jo and Marvin Thorson. Marlys Christ joined as an associate member because her professing membership is retained by the Kathryn Lutheran Church.

An associate member is a member of another denomination who wishes to come into official fellowship of a United Methodist Church, expect its pastoral care and oversight and to participate in its activities, including the holding of office, except as a voting member of the local church governing body or a United Methodist structure beyond the local church. Furthermore, associate members do not enjoy the same dueprocess rights as professing members. Therefore, the associate membership may be terminated at the discretion of the local church or when the member moves from this vicinity.

Nielson joined by transfer of membership from Berthold Baptist Church in Berthold, N.D. Osborne joined by transfer of membership from St. John's United Methodist Church in Wimbledon, N.D. The Thorsons had been members of the now closed Page (North Dakota) United Methodist Church for years, but officially joined on profession of faith because there was no record of their membership being appropriately transferred to an open United Methodist Church at the time of Page's closing.

Human Relations Offering to be Col-

lected Jan. 14— The 2024 Human Relations Sunday offering will be received on Sunday, Jan. 14. This is one of the eight special offerings each year requested by our connectional structure.
