Volunteers needed for Hi-Liner Food

Pantry— Again, this summer, the Bridges Backpack Program will host a food distribution at Valley City High School on Wednesday nights in June through early August.

The distribution will allow families to gather food items they need for a week. It takes place from 5-7 p.m. in the first room south (to the right) from door W6 on the northwest corner of the high school.

Volunteers are requested to help the families, to weigh the food, record the number of adults and children served by that amount of food, and to help carry it to their vehicles.
